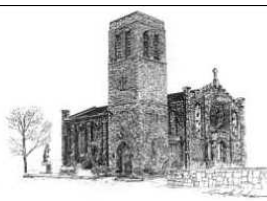

The Highlander Sea

Take the opportunity to tour the *Highlander Sea* at some point during the meeting. This 154 foot gaff-rigged topsail schooner was designed by W. Starling Burgess and built in 1924 in Essex, Massachusetts. Originally christened *Pilot*, she served 47 years as a Boston Harbor pilot ship. Dedicated to showcasing the marine lore of Port Huron, Michigan, and the Great Lakes region, Acheson Ventures, LLC, purchased *Highlander Sea* in the spring of 2002, for her role as Port Huron's flagship ambassador.
